<input type="checkbox"/> Economic Need & Humanitarian Reasons Awarded: once per year	30% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of economic need and other extreme social and political situations that challenge their well-being: low-income proof, IRS transcripts from the latest year, political asylum, a victim of natural disaster or any other document showing their current situation.

<input type="checkbox"/> Student Fair & Events Awarded: once per program	20% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of attending a student fair & event • Transcripts of previous studies with good academic performance
<input type="checkbox"/> Outstanding Academic Performance Awarded: once per year	20% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of academic performance demonstrating the student has a minimum GPA of 3.3 for undergraduate and 3.6 for graduate programs.
<input type="checkbox"/> Professors Awarded: once per year	25% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of academic participation as a teacher. • Letter of references attesting to applicants' experiences of conducting research and their interest in continuing to do so.
<input type="checkbox"/> Heavy course load term (undergraduate) Awarded: once per term	10% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of registering 5 courses per term (undergraduate programs) and demonstrating a minimum GPA of 2.5 (undergraduate) • Pay the whole tuition at the beginning of the academic term
<input type="checkbox"/> Research & Knowledge (graduate) Awarded: once per program	10% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of academic involvement in research: publications, newspapers, awards, recognition, or letters from faculty members. • References letter testifying applicant experiences of doing research and their interest in continuing doing it.
<input type="checkbox"/> Social Responsibility Awarded: once per year	10% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of community participation: church, local community, shelters, or participation in non-profit organizations
<input type="checkbox"/> Military & Police Awarded: once per program	10% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of being member of military or police institution or group
<input type="checkbox"/> Sport & Arts Awarded: once per program	10% of tuition fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of outstanding performance in arts or sports: awards, contests or Reference letters attesting to the applicant's outstanding performance
