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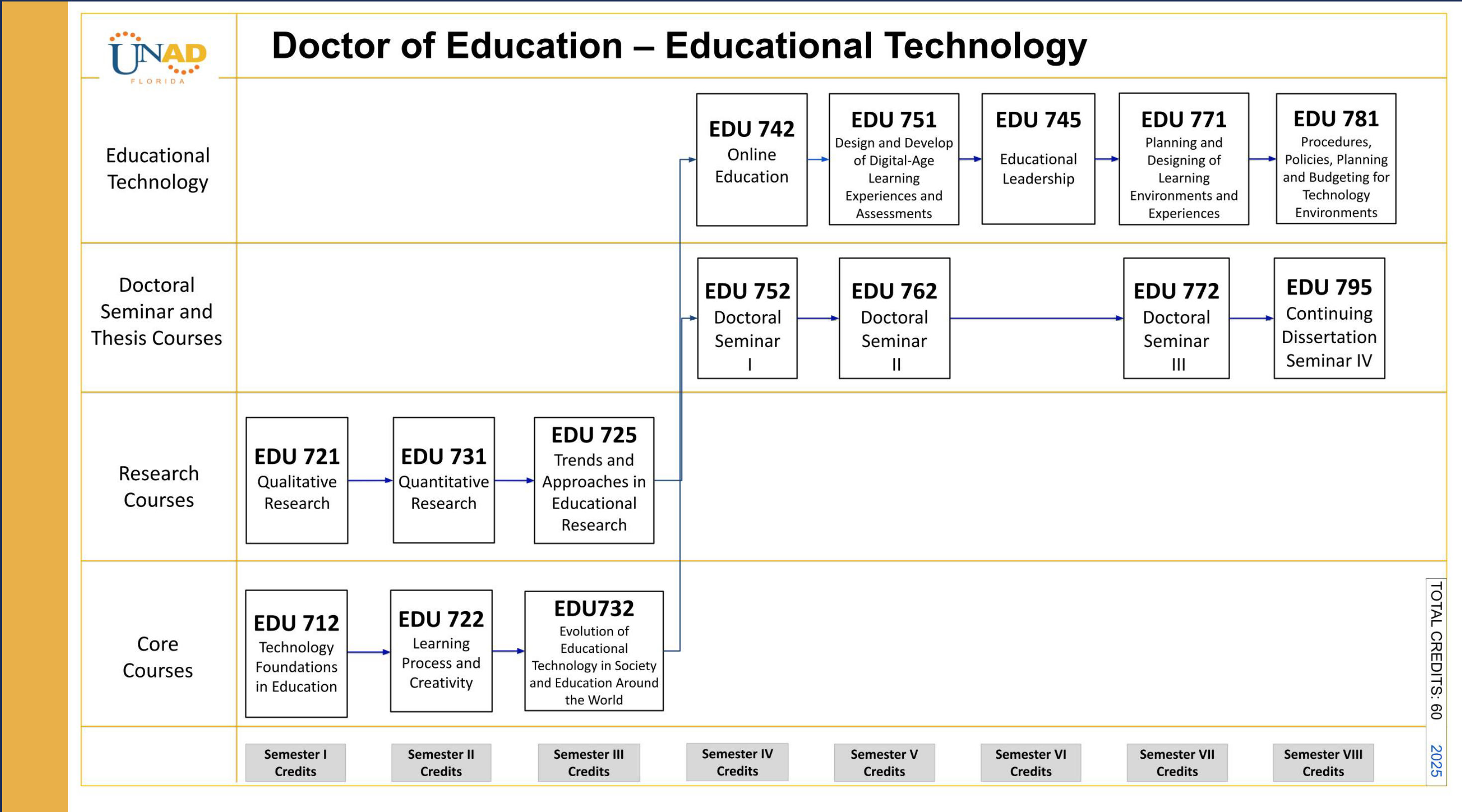

Doctorate Admission Process

UNAD Florida offers all students the opportunity to pursue Master's or Doctoral studies. Below are the steps to enroll at UNAD Florida.

1. Application Fee Payment:

- ✓ For U.S. Diplomas: A non-refundable application fee of \$100 USD is required.
- ✓ For Foreign Diplomas: A fee of \$250 USD is required. This fee includes the application, certified translation of your Master's degree diploma, and foreign credential evaluation of the degree obtained outside the United States. This service can be arranged through UNAD Florida via admission@unad.us.

2. Complete the Application Form and Submit Required Documents:

- ✓ Attach a copy of your photo identification (ID/Passport).
- ✓ **For Doctor's Program applicants:** A Bachelor's degree with a minimum GPA of 3.0 is required.

Applicants must submit original academic diplomas and transcripts, officially translated into English and evaluated by a foreign credential evaluation agency that is a member of NACES (National Association of Credential Evaluation Services).
